In early January, 2002, the Speech-Language community lost a dear friend and colleague. Dr. Joseph Gonzalez, affectionately known as “Dr. G” suddenly passed away. Dr. G was a professor at Nova Southeastern University in the Speech-Language and Communication Disorders department for many years, and he was respected and admired by students and his peers. He taught a variety of courses in the curriculum, and was instrumental in developing the first class in Technological Applications in Speech Language Pathology for our department. In his memory, the NSSLHA chapter established this scholarship, to be awarded annually to a student in this program.

- A student must be beyond the pre requisite course level
- The student must demonstrate professionalism, motivation, leadership, initiative, and personal achievement
