- ✓ Active in departmental and school activities (non-paid)
- ✓ Majoring in speech-language pathology
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation from professionals who know the applicant

- Awards are non-renewable.
- Submit a letter of interest describing (but not limited to) the following:
